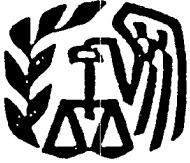

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

OF THE EPISCOPAL HOME FOR CHILDREN.

Mary G. Deavenport, Alfred G. Deavenport, Arthur G. Barnes, ...

the undersigned, all of whom are persons of full age and citizens of the District of Columbia, hereby associate ourselves for benevolent, charitable and educational purposes, as a corporation, under the laws in force in the District of Columbia, and to this end do hereby certify as follows:

First: The name or title by which such corporation shall be known in law is The Episcopal Home for Children. Second: The term for which it is organized is perpetual. Third: The particular business and objects of this corporation are the taking over of the charitable and benevolent work and of the property, real and personal, of the unincorporated Society known as The Bell Home for Children, and the maintaining at the City of Washington and elsewhere of Homes for the care, maintenance and education of necessitous white children, under the direction of members of the Protestant Episcopal Church, for the District of Washington.

Fourth: The number of the managers of such corporation for the first year shall be twelve, being the persons whose names are signed hereto.
